Wall mounted post box in Spencer Road

### Address of heritage asset

Spencer Road, near corner with Commonside East

#### Description of heritage asset

Post Officer letterbox mounted in a brick wall

Statement on how heritage asset meets Council criteria (architectural style; age & history; detailing; group value; building materials; subsequent alterations)

The wall mounted post box in Spencer Road warrants local listing against the following criterion:

 Age and history - The only remaining wall mounted post box in Mitcham. It has the royal cypher 'GR' for George V, giving it a date range of 1910 to 1936

The significance of historic post boxes to the street scene is recognised in the Joint Policy Statement by Historic England and Royal Mail (2015). This confirms the appropriateness of locally listing post boxes - "Many local authorities compile lists of buildings of local interest and many more post boxes are included as part of local designation".
